



To All Foreign Residents Raising Children In Kaga





Raising a child is never an easy task, let alone doing so in a foreign land far from home. In this pamphlet, we have compiled some useful information to assist you in all matters to do with raising your children. Please note that some details have been left out for clarity. If you would like more information, please contact the relevant departments listed under each section. Do also note that all information in this pamphlet applies only for **foreign residents whose**Certificates of Residence (住民票) are registered with Kaga City. For residents whose Certificates of Residence are not registered with Kaga City, please check with your registered city of residence for more information.

[CONSULTATION COUNTER] Kaga City Children Services Station "Kagakko Net" (same place as the Health Section)

A one-stop consultation counter for all matters to do with pregnancy, childbirth, raising children, and the like. Should you have any doubts or questions you would like clarified, please feel free to bring it to us. If you make a reservation ahead of time, we may be able to arrange for translation services in your preferred language for your consultation.

√ Submit your Pregnancy Registration Form, Receive your Maternity Health Handbook

After confirming your pregnancy with an OB-GYN, you will need to go to the City Hall's Health Section (健康課), submit your Pregnancy Registration Form (妊娠届出書), and get your Maternity Health Handbook (母子健康手帳). This Handbook will be used to track both you and your child's health. You will be required to present it during maternity health check-ups and when your child gets their vaccination shots.

✓ Go for your FREE Maternity Health Check-Ups (妊婦健診)

You will receive vouchers for free maternity health check-ups (14 times) together with your Maternity Health Handbook. These can be used at any hospital within Ishikawa Prefecture up until your 39th week of pregnancy (expected due date). Check-ups done outside Ishikawa Prefecture or from your 40th week of pregnancy onwards will be at your own expense. Please, however, keep the receipts. You will be able to get a portion of your check-up expenses refunded if you present the receipts at the City Hall's Health Section.

✓ Getting your Childbirth Expense Assistance (出產準備手当給付金)

You will qualify for receiving Childbirth Expense Assistance (10,000 yen per child) once you are past your 16th week of pregnancy. You will be required to submit an application at the City Hall's Health Section to receive this. Please note, however, that your eligibility for this scheme will expire once you are past your 14th day post-childbirth.

Learn tips about how to ensure a healthy delivery and raising a child together with your partner at these classes. The City Hall will send you a notice on with the class schedule in due time. Please make reservations for classes on your preferred dates accordingly.

✓ What If I Need A Child Seat?

The City Hall provides free second-hand child seats for parents who need it. Please register with the City Hall to qualify. Should you wish to purchase a new child seat instead, the City Hall can also subsidize 50% of the cost, up to a limit of 10,000 yen (the subsidized portion of the cost will be refunded to you after purchase).

Congratulations On Your Child's Birth!

Please do these as soon as your child is born!

✓ Submit your Birth Registration Form (出生届)

Please do this within 14 days of your child's birth.

✓ Apply For Child Benefits (児童手当)

Please do this between 1 and 15 days post-birth.

You will be eligible to receive child benefits of 5,000 to 15,000 yen per child every month up until they graduate middle school. Benefits will be split into three parts and transferred into your bank account in February, June, and October respectively. The amount of benefits you will receive will vary depending on your total household income and child's age. Please apply for your benefits at the Kaga City Hall.

✓ Apply for National Health Insurance (NHI) for your child

Please do this as soon as possible after your child's birth.

In Japan, medical bills will be subsidized as long as you are covered under the National Health Insurance system (国民健康保険). Please get your child registered for this as soon as possible, and make sure to obtain their health insurance card (健康保険証).

✓ Apply for Children Medical Fee Subsidy (こども医療費助成)

Please do this as soon as you have received your child's National Insurance Card (健康保険証)
In Kaga, all children aged 0 to 18 years old registered under the national insurance system can go to hospitals for free*. To be eligible for this, please apply for a こども医療費受給者証 (Proof of Eligibility for Children Medical Fee Subsidy) at the City Hall. Please make sure to bring this proof with you

for Children Medical Fee Subsidy) at the City Hall. Please make sure to bring this proof with you whenever you go to a hospital.

*Please note that subsidies will **NOT** apply for a portion of medical expenses (meals during hospitalization, advanced medical treatment, etc.)

Required: Your child's National Health Insurance Card (健康保険証)

✓ Apply for Lump-sum Childbirth And Childcare Allowance

Giving birth is costs money. All mothers registered under National Health Insurance will be able to receive a **Lump-sum Childbirth And Childcare Allowance** of about 420,000 yen per child. You will be eligible to receive this once you are past your 4th month (85th day) of pregnancy, even in cases of miscarriage and stillbirth. Please inquire at your hospital for more details.

To Check With Your Employer!

✓ Childbirth Assistance Benefits

Mothers ONLY

If you are employed, and will continue working at the same company after giving birth, you will be eligible to receive money (benefits, 手当金) from your employer. Do note, however, that you will **NOT** be able to receive benefits from your employer if you are **NOT** covered under your company's insurance (i.e. you are under National Health Insurance).

✓ <u>Childcare Leave Benefits</u> Both Parents Output Both Parents Both

Parents covered under a company's employment insurance will be eligible to receive money from their respective employers should they decide to take leave from work to take care of their children.

First Month Infant Check-Up (for the Postpartum Mother and Newborn Child)

Check-up to see the health condition of the mother and newborn post-childbirth. Please book a slot at a relevant medical facility within the prefecture, and bring along your check-up voucher (subsidy voucher) when you go for your check-up. *If you have returned to your hometown prefecture to give birth, and will be receiving the check-up at a non-Ishikawa medical facility, a portion of your check-up expenses will be eligible for subsidy. Home Visit for the Postpartum Mother and Newborn Child (Premature birth) ★

A midwife or public health nurse from the City Hall will be making a home visit to check on the condition of the mother postpartum and baby. The midwife/public health nurse will take weight measurements, and provide advice and counselling on topics such as postpartum lifestyle management, breastfeeding, and infant care as required.

4½ Month Infant Health Check-Up ★

Venue: Health Center (Kaga Exchange Plaza Sakura, Level 2) 保健センター

(かが交流プラザさくら2階)

Content: Physical Examination, Height- and Weight-taking, Instruction on Puberty and Nutrition Matters (in groups), individual counselling

Postpartum Care Services (Up until <1 year postpartum)

For mothers unsure of how to care for their infant properly, or mothers and children with physical or psychological conditions that require extra attention, additional assistance by midwives and other specialists are also available at a fee.

E.g. Home visits – 2,000 yen per session (up to 4 hours)

<u>Pre-childbirth & Postpartum Household Helper</u> Dispatch (Up until <1 year postpartum)

Household helper dispatch services are available for mothers who find themselves physically unable to do household chores and take care of their children properly postpartum.

Content: Height- and Weight-taking, Weaning food making demonstration, individual counselling (*Registration required)

Check-up to see the health condition of your child. Please book a slot at any relevant medical facility within the prefecture, and bring along your check-up voucher (also your subsidy voucher) when you bring your child for their check-up.



1 Year 6 Month Health Check-Up *

Venue: Health Center (Kaga Exchange Plaza Sakura, Level 2) 保健センター(かが交流プラザさくら 2 階)

Content: Physical examination, Dental check-up, Height- and Weight-taking, individual counselling, nutrition counselling, dental health counselling



3rd Year Health Check-Up (3 years and 6 months old) ★

Venue: Health Center (Kaga Exchange Plaza Sakura, Level 2) 保健センター(かが交流プラザさくら 2 階)

Content: Physical examination, Dental check-up, Height- and Weight-taking, individual counselling, nutrition counselling, dental health counselling, hearing and vision check, urine test, speech ability check



★ You will receive a check-up reminder from the City Hall near the date either by post or via phone call.

About Vaccinations

When your child reaches the eligible age for vaccinations, you may use the city's vaccination vouchers to get <u>free</u> vaccinations for your child at any relevant medical facility. Households with children of eligible age will receive these vaccination vouchers from the City Hall <u>via post</u>. Please bring these <u>vaccination vouchers</u> and your <u>Maternity Health Handbook</u> along when getting your child vaccinated.

*Please plan out a vaccination schedule for your child with your doctor.

Childcare

Nursery School (保育園) & Certified Childcare Centers (認定こども園)

These facilities provide daytime childcare services for parents who are unable to take care of their children full-time due to work. Nursery schools usually operate from 8:30 to 16:30, and take children of ages 0 to 5 years old. Fees will vary according to household income. Some nursery schools also provide additional services, such as extended hours (past 16:30), as well as weekend and nighttime childcare as and when needed. If you would like your child to be enrolled, please submit an application, either directly to your preferred nursery school, or to the City Hall's Childcare Support Section.

You can also temporarily leave your child at nursery schools, even if they are not enrolled in one, in the event where parents are unable to take care of the child due to either illness or other urgent matters. Fees are $1,500 \sim 1,800$ yen for a full day's care (meals included), and half of that for half days (no meals). Please inquire at your preferred nursery for more details.

Between the period of your pregnancy up until around your child's birth, you may also register for the My Nursery School Registration Scheme (マイ保育園登録制度). Registration is free, and once registered, you will be able to have childcare consultations and nursery school visits at your preferred nursery school, until your child turns 3. Under the scheme, you will also be entitled to <u>free</u> use of temporary childcare services <u>up to 3 times</u> (<u>limited to weekday morning sessions</u>). For registration, please inquire directly at your preferred nursery school.

After School Children's Club (放課後児童クラブ)

These facilities provide childcare services for elementary school children during after school hours and school vacations for working parents. Fees range around $8,000 \sim 15,000$ yen.

Short-term Childcare Assistance Services

In the event where parents are unable to take care of children (2 to 18 years old) due to sudden illness, emergencies, or work outside of usual childcare facility operating hours (at night, weekends, etc.), they can be temporarily left in the care of children's homes. Kaga Family Support Center

We provide a host of miscellaneous childcare support services, ranging from postpartum infant care assistance, to afterhours childcare, transport to and fro childcare facilities, and ad-hoc childcare in cases of hospitalization, familial rites, ceremonies, events (including for mum and dad's couple outings). **Registration is required for access to services.**

Childcare For When Your Child Is Sick

Temporary Childcare For Sick Or Just-Recovered Children

These facilities provide childcare for sick or just-recovered children of ages 0 to 6th grade of elementary school when parents are unable to take care of them due to work or other matters.

Hours: Weekdays, $8:30 \sim 17:30$

Fees: 1,500 yen for 1 Full Day (additional 500 yen if meals are included)

Required: Registration form*, Doctor's contact form (*Please register beforehand if you require this service. You

may also be allowed to register and leave your child in our care on the day of in the event of emergencies.)

If You Have A Child With Disabilities

Assistance Schemes For Children With Disabilities

Kaga City has schemes under which families can obtain additional child benefits and subsidies on medical expenses and the like if they have children with disabilities (physical or otherwise). If you suspect that your child may have a disability, please approach the Nursing Care and Welfare Section for assistance as soon as possible.

If You Are A Single Parent

Assistance Schemes For Single Parent Families

Medical Expenses Subsidies*

For single parents covered under National Health Insurance receiving general medical consultations, the portion of fees incurred after the first 1,000 yen will be eligible for subsidy.

Child Support Benefits*

Single parents, or guardians looking after the child on behalf of the parents will be eligible for child support benefits.

*A household income check will be conducted to confirm eligibility.

Childcare Support Center (子育て支援センター)

The Center provides childcare support to families living in Kaga City through providing childcare counselling services, as well as spaces and events to encourage family bonding. Its main scope of activities include providing play spaces for children not enrolled in nursery school, and organizing parent-child bonding events, such as baby massage, yoga, and snack-making classes. The Center also releases a newsletter once every 2 months with schedule information on nursery school open house days, childcare interest group activities, and more.

Access Map


