Certificates of Residence, Family Register, Notifications

Please be sure to notify the city hall whenever you move, marry, get pregnant, or give birth. When you

do, please be sure to bring your passport, driver's license, or some other official identification with you.

Notification of Moving In, Moving Out, or Changing Residence

Please notify the city hall when you do any of the following: Moving In (Moving to Kaga City from another city, town or village) • Moving Out (Moving from Kaga City to another city, town, or village) • Changing Residence (Moving to a different residence within Kaga City)

Notification of Moving Out \rightarrow You can notify up to 14 days prior to moving.

Notification of Moving In \rightarrow You must notify within 14 days of moving in.

Notification of Changing Residence \rightarrow You must notify within 14 days of moving to your new home.

Notification of Birth, Marriage, Divorce or Death

Please notify the city hall when you get married, have a child, get divorced, or when a friend or family member passes away.

Notification of Marriage \rightarrow You must notify the city hall when you get married

Notification of Divorce \rightarrow You must notify the city hall when you get divorced.

Notification of Birth \rightarrow You must notify the city hall within 14 days of giving birth, including the day the child is born.

Notification of Death \rightarrow You must notify the city hall within 7 days (3 months if they passed away in another country) upon learning that the person has passed away.

Residence Card, Special Permanent Resident Certificate

A foreign residence card is a form of identification distributed by the Regional Immigration Administrative Offices to foreign residents who have received approval to temporarily reside in Japan. Special Permanent Residents receive a Special Permanent Resident Certificate.

My Number System

The My Number System was started in October 2015. Foreign residents with Certificates of Residence (mid-length residents, special permanent residents) will be sent a notification of their My Number via mail by the city hall. To prevent fraudulent use of your My Number, be careful not to tell others your My Number unless absolutely necessary.



[Personal Identification Number Card]

Your Personal Identification Number Card has your My Number written on it, and can be used as a form of identification. You are required to submit an application at the city hall to receive a Personal Identification Number Card.

Registration and Verification of your Personal Stamp

In Japan, when buying land, a home, or a car, among other things, you need a special personal stamp. You must register your stamp at the city hall.

XVerification form (for partial copies of Family Registers, Certificates of Residence, and Personal Stamp Verification) issuing services are only available until 6:30PM on weekdays

Separation and Disposal of Garbage



Each district in Kaga City has a different day of the week for garbage collection. Please refer to the Garbage Collection Calendar distributed by the city hall for the specific days and times for garbage pickup in your district. Please check with your landlord or neighbors for the garbage pickup location in your neighborhood. In Japan, there are strict and specific rules about how to separate different kinds of garbage. Please do your best as a citizen of the city to follow them.

•Large Garbage (Bulky Garbage)

Large pieces of garbage such as furniture, bicycles, stove heaters, rugs, and futons (Bulky Garbage) are not collected. Please dispose of them at the Environmental Beautification Center on your own. Some large items cannot be processed at the Center, so please refer to your Garbage Calendar to check the kinds of garbage you can dispose of at the Center beforehand.

Payment for Usage

Usage of tap water and sewage disposal is paid for on a monthly basis. You can pay by bringing the bill to your bank or a convenience store, or set up automatic deductions from your bank account.

Taxes

In Japan, there are National Taxes, Prefectural Taxes, and City/Town/Village Taxes. Foreign residents receiving a steady income and who have lived in Japan for more than a year are obligated to pay the same taxes as Japanese citizens.

[City • Prefectural Taxes]

This tax, levied by the city and prefecture, is based on your income in the previous year. The tax is to be paid to your city, town, or village of residence, calculating from January 1st. If you work at a company, it will be automatically deducted from your monthly paycheck. For those who do not have it automatically deducted, the city hall will send you a Tax Notification along with a tax payment form via post, which you can then take to a bank to pay. If you are leaving Japan permanently, please designate a tax representative, and inform the Kaga City Taxation Section once decided. Your tax payment form will then be sent by the city hall via post to your designated tax representative.

[Fixed Assets Tax]

Tax levied on any land or homes you own as of January 1st.

[Light Motor Vehicle Tax]



A tax levied on any light motor vehicles you may own in the city, calculating from April 1st. This tax applies to all vehicles regardless of condition. Only vehicles for which vehicle disposal forms have been submitted will not be taxed.

◆How to Make Payments

Kaga City will send out payment slips, which you must then pay at a bank or convenience store within the indicated period.

XIf you do not pay within the indicated period, an additional late payment fee will be levied.

Childbirth and Child-Rearing

In Kaga City, when you give birth or are raising children, there are many forms of support available to you. When you find out that you are pregnant, please go to city hall to receive a Mother and Child Health Notebook.

Infertility Consultation

If you have been trying to get pregnant for over one year with no success, you may be infertile. The Ishikawa Infertility Consultation Center provides infertility counseling services. Consultations can be conducted in person (reservation required), over phone, or via email.

Infertility Treatment Subsidy Program/Miscarriage Treatment Subsidy Program

In Kaga City, there are subsidies available to help offset some of the treatment costs for infertility or inability to carry a pregnancy to full term (including miscarriage and stillbirth).

Distribution of Mother and Child Health Notebooks

When you find out that you are pregnant, please get yourself examined by a gynecologist. Please also turn in a Notification of Pregnancy form to the city hall's Health Section and collect your Mother and Child Health Notebook. The Notebook is used to record information about the mother's health and the child's examination results, as well as records of the child's vaccinations, so please be sure to keep it safe. Make sure to bring it with you for any medical examinations undertaken during your pregnancy, when your child gets vaccinations, or when you visit a medical clinic or hospital. When you receive your Mother and Child Health Notebook, you will also receive consultation vouchers for a Pregnancy Examination, Childbirth Examination, and Infant Examination.

Midwifery Facility

If you have a low income and cannot afford the regular medical costs of childbirth, you can use a midwifery facility.

Childbirth Preparation Care Provision Service

If you are a registered resident of Kaga City, and over 16 weeks pregnant, you can receive a ¥10,000 subsidy for each fetus you are carrying. Please submit an application at the Health Section after your 16th week of pregnancy. You may also consult a nurse about any concerns you may have about your pregnancy during your application.

What to bring: Mother and Child Health Notebook, bank book, your personal stamp.

You can no longer apply for the subsidy 14 days after you give birth, so please apply while you are pregnant.

Economic Support at Time of Birth

To offset the medical costs incurred before and after childbirth, a one-off subsidy will be provided to you by your medical insurance.

Pregnancy Examination

A medical examination to check on the mother's health and for any irregularities with the child. Please bring along the Pregnancy Examination consultation voucher handed to you with your Mother and Child Health Notebook to your trusted medical service provider to receive the examination. In cases of prolonged pregnancies, pregnancy examinations taken after the expected due date (40 weeks of pregnancy) will be partially subsidized. Please consult the city hall's Health Section for further information.

Notification of Birth

A notification form is to be submitted to the city hall within 14 days (inclusive of the day of birth) of your child's birth. Please bring along your child's Birth Certificate (to be filled out by your doctor), your Mother and Child Health Notebook, and your personal stamp with you.

Post-Childbirth Health Management

Mothers will be required to go for a maternity health examination approximately a month after giving birth to check for any post-childbirth anomalies. Infants will also be required to undergo a health examination in the same period to check on their growth progress. Please bring along the Childbirth Examination and Infant Examination consultation vouchers handed to you with your Mother and Child Health Notebook to your trusted medical service provider to receive the respective examinations.

Infant Check-Ups

In Kaga City, infant check-ups are performed at 4.5 months, 1 year 6 months, and 3 years 2 months of age. Notices will be sent to households with children reaching those ages. Please bring along your Mother and Child Health Notebook when you come in for a check-up.

Vaccinations

Infants can receive free vaccinations against infectious diseases. Please bring along the vaccination voucher handed to you with your Mother and Child Health Notebook to your trusted medical service provider for your child to receive the vaccination.

Childbirth and Childcare Support

In Kaga City, there are various programs to support parents through the childbirth and child-rearing processes, such as Papa and Mama Pregnancy Classes, New Mother and Infant Visits, Post-childbirth Family Helper Recruitment services, Post-childbirth Care Assistance, and Infant Classes. Child Medical Subsidies

Subsidies are available to help cover medical costs for hospitalization or hospital visits for children up to 18 years of age.

※For infant illnesses, in addition to this program, there are many other publicly-funded medical care programs such as the Premature Infant Care Program, the Specific Pediatric Chronic Diseases Treatment Program, the Child-Rearing Medical Care Program, the Rehabilitation for Children with Disabilities Program, and more. Subsidies for Children with Disabilities

Child Safety Seat Sharing

In Japan, it is required by law that children under six years of age be seated in a child safety seat when riding in a car. At the city hall, people who no longer need their child safety seats are put into contact with people who need them so that the seats can be re-used. Subsidies are also available for families interested in purchasing child safety seats upon the birth of the child.

Daycares and Certified Childcare Centers

Daycares are facilities at which childcare professionals take care of children whose guardians have work, are ill, are due to give birth, or for whatever reason are unable to take care of their children during the day. Certified Child Centers are facilities that combine the functions of both a daycare and a kindergarten.

In order to respond to the needs of increasingly diverse families, daycares also offer special childcare services such as after-hours care, holiday and weekend care, and nighttime childcare.

For pre-elementary school children not enrolled in daycares, temporary childcare services are available to assist guardians who are temporarily unable to care for their children due to illness or urgent matters. Fees are priced at $\pm 1,500 \sim 1,800$ for one day of care (including meals), and half that for half a day of care. The details of this program may differ at private daycares.

Short-Term Childcare Support Program

Japan's education system consists of six years of elementary school, three years of junior high school, and three years of high school. Elementary and junior high education are mandatory. Public schools start in April, and finish in March of the next year. While residents with foreign citizenship are not required to go to school, they can enroll in Japanese elementary and junior high schools if so desired. If you wish to enroll your children in a local school, please apply at the







Medical Insurance System

The Medical Insurance System is a system in which participants regularly pay a set amount in taxes so that everyone can get medical care for illness or injuries without worrying about the cost. When you enter into the Medical Insurance System you will receive an Insurance Card. When you receive treatment or check-ups at hospitals or clinics, by showing your Insurance Card you will only have to pay 10-30% of the total cost. If you are not enrolled in the Medical Insurance System, you must pay the entirety of the cost yourself.

1. Social Insurance (Health Insurance through your employer)

Insurance that covers employees and their families. The cost of insurance is split 50-50 between the employer and the employee. Please check with your employer for further details.

2. National Health Insurance

Foreign nationals under 75 years of age who are not enrolled in Social Insurance and whose stay in Japan exceeds 3 months must enroll in National Health Insurance.

3. Latter-Stage Elderly Healthcare

Foreign nationals over 75 years of age whose stay in Japan exceeds 3 months must enroll in the Latter-Stage Elderly Healthcare system.

People whose stay in Japan exceeds 3 months must enter into either National Health Insurance or the Latter-Stage Elderly Healthcare System unless they meet any of the following criteria:

•People enrolled under Social Insurance via their employer (Note: employees over 75 years of age must be enrolled under the Latter-Stage Elderly Healthcare System)

- •People on welfare assistance
- •People who are in Japan to receive medical care or people with a Designated Activities visa who support the daily life activities of those people
- •People who, under their home country's social security arrangement, do not adopt Japan's Medical Insurance System and instead use their home country's Medical Insurance System.

Furthermore, even if a person's actual stay in Japan is less than 3 months, it is sometimes possible

for those with an Entertainer, Technical Intern Training, Dependent, Official, or Designated Activities visa to enroll under the National Health Insurance or the Latter-Stage Elderly Healthcare System if they have documentation indicating a period of stay exceeding 3 months. Please consult the city hall's National Insurance and Pension Section for more information if this applies to you.

Long-Term Care Insurance System

A system of social support to ensure that elderly people requiring long-term nursing care are still able to lead independent lifestyles. Eligible persons are automatically enrolled once they reach 40 years of age, and can receive nursing care services once their need for long-term care has been recognized. Foreign residents whose stay in Japan exceeds 3 months are also covered by Long-Term Care Insurance.

National Pension

The public pension system is set in place to provide pension money for when you grow old, become disabled, or lose your primary provider. There is a National Pension fund as well as a Public Welfare fund. People from 20 to 60 years of age with a Japanese address must pay into the National Pension fund regardless of citizenship.

If you are returning to your home country and fulfill <u>ALL</u> of the following conditions:

- · Have been paying into the National Pension fund for at least six months
- Have submitted a Moving Out Notification to the City Hall, and
- Have obtained re-entry permission into Japan

You are eligible to apply for a lump-sum reimbursement for withdrawing from the pension program. Please consult the city hall for instructions on how to do so.

Notebooks for People with Disabilities

Notebooks for People with Disabilities are used as proof of your disability and are required when you utilize any Welfare Facilities. The type of notebook you will be given depends on the type and severity of your disability: for those with physical disabilities, there is the Physical Disability Notebook; for those with intellectual disabilities, there is the Rehabilitation Notebook; and for those with mental disabilities, there is the Mental Disability Insurance Welfare Notebook.

Medical Institutions

There are 6 hospitals and 41 clinics in Kaga City. When you go for a medical consultation, make sure to bring along your Insurance Card. If you do not bring your Insurance Card, you will have to bear the full cost of treatment.

Evacuation drills are regularly organized by the Neighborhood Associations of each district.

Foreign residents are also highly encouraged to take part in these sessions.

Staying Prepared

• Disaster Preparedness Guidebook for Foreign Residents Please read carefully the Disaster Preparedness Guidebook for Foreign Residents for the knowledge you need to survive in the event of a disaster

• Talk About Disaster Preparedness with Your Family

Talk with your family about the kinds of natural disasters you might encounter in your neighborhood, as well as the safe and potential danger spots in your home.

Discuss evacuation plans with your family, such as how you will contact each other and which evacuation area to go to in the event of a disaster.

• Emergency Supply Bag

Prepare a backpack with the following supplies that you can take with you at a moment's notice in the event of a disaster.

- ·Radio ·Pocket flashlight with extra batteries
- Water bottle

• Emergency rations (Ready-to-eat food, canned food that <u>do not</u> require a can opener to snacks, hard candy)

·Clothing, underwear, towels

- · Valuables, identification, money
- Medicine

Tsunami

In the event of an earthquake, it is possible that a tsunami might follow. It is estimated that if an earthquake were to occur along the coastline near Kaga, it would take approximately ten minutes for a tsunami to reach the shore. If there is a possibility of a tsunami, immediately evacuate to higher ground.

Floods • Windstorms

In recent years, abnormally high rainfall has been increasing in frequency, and has been causing significant damage in various regions across the country.

In the event of heavy rain or strong winds, please listen carefully to radio or television emergency broadcasts and follow any evacuation instructions.

Landslides

If there are any warning signs of a potential cliff collapse, landslide, or mudflow, evacuate as soon as possible.

Warning signs include: falling cliff rocks, strong water flows off a cliff, cracks in the cliff face, etc.
